Following points were discussed in the meeting.

The meeting began with Dr. Sonal Ashok Ubale reviewing the minutes from the previous committee meeting. The members were given opportunity to provide feedback and suggest amendments. After a brief discussion, the minutes were unanimously approved confirming that they accurately represented the discussions and decisions made in the last session.

Dr. Sonal Ashok Ubale presented an update on the progress of ongoing academic programs. She highlighted the success of recent activities, such as new elective courses and student-led projects. Prof. Pradnya Shashank Sonawane elaborated on the participation levels in these programs, noticing a significant increase in student engagement. Mr. Yograj Waghmare emphasized the need for continuous monitoring and evaluation to ensure that the academic programs meet the institution's standards and students' expectations.

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Prof Pradnya Shashank Sonawane introduced several new curriculum proposals aimed at keeping the institution's offerings aligned with industry trends and academic advancement. She proposed the inclusion of new courses in data science and artificial intelligence, which were met with positive feedback. Mr. Yogiraj Waghmare suggested revising the syllabus of certain core subjects to include recent developments in the field. After thorough discussion, the committee agreed to implement these changes with Dr. Sonal Ashok Ubale, stressing the importance of faculty training of effectively deliver the new curriculum.

The discussion then shifted to faculty recruitment and development. Mr. Yogiraj Waghmare presented a plan for upcoming faculty recruitment drives, emphasizing the need for highly qualified candidates with a strong research background. Dr. Sonal Ashok Ubale proposed organizing professional development workshops to enhance the teaching

skills of existing faculty members. Prof. Pradnya Shashank Sonasane supported the idea, suggesting that these workshops focus on modern pedagogical methods and the use of technology in the classroom.

The committee reviewed the current student support services including counseling, academic advising and career guidance. Mr. Yograj Waghmare raised concerns about the accessibility of these services and proposed measures to improve them. Prof. Pradnya Shashank Sonasane recommended increasing the number of counselors and introducing peer mentoring programs to improve and provide additional support. Dr. Sonal Ashok Ubale emphasized the importance of creating a supportive environment that addresses the academic and emotional needs of students.

The final agenda item was a discussion on campus safety and security measures. Mr. Yograj Waghmare led this discussion, highlighting recent incidents that

underscored the need for enhanced security protocols. He proposed several measures, including the installation of additional surveillance cameras and the implementation of more rigorous access control system. Prof. Pradyas Sheshank Sonawane suggested organizing regular safety drills to prepare students and staff for emergencies. Dr. Sonal Ashok Ubale supported these initiatives, noticing that a safe campus environment is crucial for the well being and success of the entire college community.
