The meeting of the women redressal cell began at 4:00 pm with opening remarks by the women representative prof. Kajal Sable, the women representative welcomed all members and outlined the agenda, In attendance were Dr Asmita Salve, Dr. Sonal Ubale, Prof. Pradnya mam, Prof. Namrata G, Prof. Neha Sonawane and Prof. Rajendra Bhagat.

Meeting started with reviewing the last meeting points and updates and status of making new washrooms was taken into discussion.

The topic of discussion was regarding the seating arrangement in computer lab, Namrata mam led the discussion by saying that girls & boys seats in computer lab anywhere without any separate seating arrangement for girls and boys, girls seating next to boys found themselves in feeling uncomfortable.

On further discussion it was observed that the current setup does not fully address concerns and utilization issues.

After discussing various options and solutions Prof. Neha Sonawane put forth a solution to make girls boys computer lab different.

Members discussed the potential benefits of having separate computer labs for boys and girls, including improved focus and a more comfortable environment.

Dr. Asmita Mam highlighted feedback from students and staff about the desire for

Separate facilities.

The need to address concerns related to privacy and personal space was emphasized. All members were agreed to make separate boys girls computer lab and to allocate existing computer lab spaces to be converted into separate boys and girls labs.

Prof. Neha Senawane mam concluded the meeting with closing remarks summarizing the key points and solutions and expressed gratitude for the active participation of all members.
